CAMPING TERMS AND CONDITIONS for L.D. LUCEY MEMORIAL PARK

The Reserve is managed by the Trustee, L. D. Lucey Memorial Park Inc. The following terms and conditions apply to allow everyone to have an enjoyable and safe camping experience.

Please be considerate towards other campers.

1. The Trustee or their nominated assistants (including the Trustee Management Committee, Police, Security, and gate staff) appointed by the Trustee have the right to:
 - a. Refuse entry, or terminate occupancy, at any time to any person without reason.
 - b. Evict a person or persons and remove their property from the premises for unruly conduct or behavior or for causing damage to property located on the Reserve.
2. **Please note:** Anti-social and abusive behavior to volunteers, police and security staff will result in instant eviction from the weekend event, no refund will be granted.
3. Campers must obey any lawful instruction given by an authorized officer of the Trustee.
4. Any person attending the Reserve is responsible for their own behavior and should assist in ensuring the behavior of any member of their group is considerate to others.
5. The Trustee accepts no responsibility whatsoever for persons caravans, camps, motor homes or vehicles and their contents whilst they remain on the Reserve.
6. Consider your neighbours and keep noise to a minimum. No undue noise after 1am. All occupants have the right to enjoy the peace and quiet and have a good nights' sleep.
7. Caught trespassing on neighboring properties will result in instant eviction from the event. **NO REFUND.**
8. All drinking water must be boiled before consumption.
9. Campers must keep their site clean and tidy, leaving it as they found it. Do not disturb vegetation.
10. Rubbish must be suitably wrapped and deposited in the bins provided or take your rubbish home with you. Recycling is recommended, bags can be provided for this purpose, there are charity groups that would appreciate your recycling. Rubbish must not be buried or left in fireplaces.
11. The Trustees would appreciate your cooperation in making this weekend event **GLASS FREE**, broken glass is dangerous to patrons, also to the stock that provides the entertainment for the weekend, there is a multitude of choices out there in **CANS** for you to enjoy.
12. Contained Campfires **OFF** the ground are permissible, must be extinguished with water before leaving.
13. Bring your own firewood. Firewood **MUST NOT** be collected from surrounding privately owned land.
14. Common showers and toilets must be kept clean and tidy. Please consider other uses when showering as we operate on a limited water supply. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult while using the amenities.
15. Illegal drugs, offensive language, excessive use of alcohol and underage consumption of alcohol will not be tolerated.
16. Parents are responsible for their children's behavior and conduct. Any damages will be their responsibility.
17. Speed limit is 10km/hr on the reserve, Queensland Road rules apply.
18. All vehicles must be registered and only driven by a licensed driver.
19. Do not drink and drive. Random breath testing will be occurring around the roads and inside the Reserve. We recommend you have a designated driver or seek alternative transport.
20. Generators, loud music, and loud use of vehicles are not permitted.
21. **STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED** Dogs and horses don't mix, please make arrangements for your dogs to stay at home for the weekend.
22. No firearms or weapons of any kind are permitted. Appliances such as axes can only be used to split firewood or drive tent pegs.
